

TIME FOR TEA & GARDEN CENTRE EXPLORER RIDE

A round trip that uses tracks and quiet lanes to visit the nearby Emcy Garden Centre and Tearooms. The garden centre is open every day from 9.30am to 5.00pm (10.30 to 4.30 on Sundays).

Distance: Around 3.5 miles.

Conditions: An easy riding round trip.

PLEASE TAKE CARE TO LOOK AHEAD FOR OBSTACLES WHEN RIDING ON TRAILS - AND ADVISE THOSE WHO ARE BEHIND YOU

Turn right on to the road out of the cycle hire centre and at the junction turn right again. Follow this road until it takes a sharp right, carry straight on at this point down a track with a sign saying 'No Tourers Beyond This Point'). Continue to the crossing of the North Norfolk Railway, cross over and continue straight on along the path.

Where the path meets the road turn left. At most times this road is fairly quiet, however if you have youngsters with you please keep them on your inside or ahead of you. The road is straight and visibility is good.

Continue along this road for half a mile until you reach the Emcy Garden Centre. Lock up your cycles near the picnic tables area while you explore the garden centre and tearooms.

Once you have finished exploring the garden centre, Re-trace your route to return to the train line. Cross the track once again. Once on Kelling Heath side, turn left. Follow the railway line parallel until the track splits. Bear right and carry on (Note the 'Kelling Heath View Point' on your left) until you reach the tarmac surface. Carry on ahead into the woodland. Follow the road around to the right until you near the cycle hire centre.
